



He was listed as one of the 100 guardians of faith in Nigeria in 2020, He is a Special Marshal in the Federal Road safety Corps (FRSC) .

With conscious demands for marketplace influence and dominance, Daniel Olawande holds a BSc. in Biology Education, Msc Educational Psychology, Post Graduate Diploma in Theology, Basic and Advance courses in Daystar Leadership Academy, Public Speaking Masterclass, Market Place Readiness Program, Creative Intelligence Certification course by the World Creativity and Intelligence Team Miami University, Oxford, Ohio, USA and an alumni of the Texas Bible institute, U.S.A. PDaniel Olawande currently serves as Founder and Principal in Flaming College, a mentorship platform to raise, build and equip people for all round effectiveness and The Purpose Discovery Nation, an e-learning platform to guide people through purpose discovery, development and deployment. He is a songwriter and minister with a debut album titled The Outpouring, He is an Actor and Author who has authored different best sellers and transformational books like Fire Tonic and Burden Capsules amongst several others. He is happily married to Oluwanifemi Olawande and they are blessed with two beautiful princesses.



Ada Ogochukwu Ehi Moses is a Christian singer-songwriter, Recording and Performing artist professionally known as Ada Ehi. Born and raised in Lagos, Nigeria in the early '80s. Ada was introduced into music ministry as a backing vocalist for the child star "Tosin Jegede" around the young age of ten. She attended Lagos State University where she obtained a degree in Chemical and Polymer Engineering.


With a career spanning more than a decade, Ehi released her debut album in November 2009, titled "Undenied". The album garnered several positive reviews and served as a stepping stone in launching her career in the gospel music scene. She has since written some of Africa's inspired gospel anthems, and successfully delivered five other studio albums including her second album "Lifted and So Fly", a two-disc album released in November 2013, "Future Now" released on October 2017, "Ada's EP Vol.1" a 5 track EP released in 2019. and "Born of God" which was released in 2020.

Ada Ehi has collaborated with several artists including Nathaniel Bassey, Sinach, Limoblaze, Dante Bowe, Buchi amongst many others.

Ada's singles have also created a whirlwind of sensation across the world. Most notably, her song 'Only You Jesus' currently has over 100 million views on YouTube alone and was listed on YouTube's top 20 most viewed songs of the decade.

She's established a foundation called Ada Ehi Foundation which works to provide education opportunities for children in rural communities across Nigeria. Her foundation has also donated funds to support medical care and other essential needs in these communities.



ADAPTIVE COPING STRATEGIES TO NAVIGATE LIFE'S CHALLENGES

The times we are in is quite challenging and very difficult to navigate. Just like a ship on the boat, faced with the storms and the different elements of the sea so is life with its very many challenges (Personal Challenges, Relationship Challenges, Career Challenges,

Financial Challenges, Health Challenges). To effectively navigate these challenges, adaptive coping strategies becomes a prerequisite.

Adaptive coping strategies refer to techniques and methods used to manage and overcome stressful, difficult, or traumatic situations in a healthy and constructive way. These strategies help individuals adapt to adversity, build resilience, and promote overall well-being.

Key Characteristics of Adaptive Coping Strategies:*

- 1. Effective in managing stress and emotions
- 2. Promote problem-solving and decision-making
- 3. Enhance resilience and adaptability
- 4. Foster personal growth and self-awareness
- 5. Improve relationships and social support
- 6. Reduce negative emotions and behaviour
- 7. Increase positive emotions and well-being

Adaptive coping strategies help us navigate life's challenges with resilience and effectiveness. Here are some strategies we can adopt:

- Challenge negative thoughts
- · Reframe perspective
- Focus on the present moment
- · Learn from failures and setbacks
- Practice self-awareness
- Foster a sense of purpose



Develop a growth mind-set

- · Practice gratitude
- Set realistic goals and deadlines
- · Prioritize sleep and exercise
- · Healthy eating habits
- · Engage in hobbies and creative activities
- Self-compassion and self-forgiveness
- Mindfulness meditation (Deep breathing exercises, journaling, grounding techniques, emotional labelling)
- Humor and laughter
- · Creative expression (art, music, writing)
- · Connect with friends and family
- · Seek professional help (therapy, counselling)

Be aware of these negative coping strategies. They can exacerbate problems or create new ones. Examples include:

- 1. Substance abuse
- 2. Avoidance behaviours
- 3. Denial or suppression of emotions
- 4. Aggression or violence
- 5. Escapism (e.g., excessive gaming, TV watching)


Remember, life challenges are opportunities for growth and learning.




